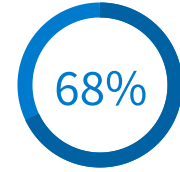

Ask the residents in general if they want or don't want sidewalks

Sidewalk is preferred but buffer between vehicles and cart/pedestrian lane more important

The entrance on Camino de plata is a must. But I don't think much needs to be done. There is not a lot of traffic on the street but people do walk their dogs on the street or drive golf carts. It doesn't seem to be a big problem.

Is there any reason pedestrians can't use the parking lane if no cars are parked there?

Make sure walking on one side both ways. Parking only on one side of the street. Golf and biking both ways as seen.

Sidewalks added and ability to enter Casa Dorado from Rancho Palmeras

No bump outs. They are hazards to pedestrians

Like certain aspects but reduce the amount of parking absence of turning lanes would affect traffic flow. Reduce buffer zones more landscaping!

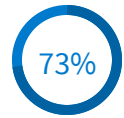
A balance of a pedestrian walkway & street parking. Possibly a walkway on one side & designated parking on the other side of the street.

Sidewalk needed more so than Rancho Palmeras

No median sidewalk - poor access for neighborhoods, poor lighting or needs excessive lighting (winter darkness), not safe for crossing

If cook ends up with walkways lighting will be needed

Use east side of Cook for sidewalk area.

Please paint more sharrows on streets with no bike lanes. Please put up more share the road signs

There is a tremendous amount of foot traffic and cyclist currently on cook, anything you do is better than what there is now

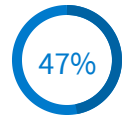
If one lane lowers speed please implement instead of two lanes on cook

Sidewalk incorporated where grass is now on east side as presented by an association representative NOT decreasing the number of lanes. One sidewalk can have foot traffic both ways. There too much existing traffic to reduce the lanes. Dangerous near coffee shop

Definitely sidewalks and clear distance/distinction between walking pedestrians & bike lane/golf carts

You have the ability and neighbor cooperation to put the sidewalks into the grass berm at the east side of cook. Then remain with 2 vehicle lanes, not reducing to one. Please.

Please paint bicycle lanes green or blue to identify and segregate better

Sidewalks on both east and west side of Cook Streets are a high priority - pedestrian safety!

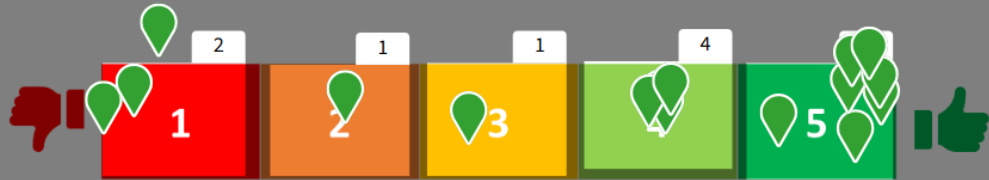
